The organization was founded in 2010 and has completed a journey of 12 years in September, 2022.

## Goals and objectives

Since its establishment in 2010, OBHIZATRIK Foundation has been actively working on the following sectors: Poverty elimination, Education, Health and Nutrition, Human Rights and Environment.

The organization's objectives, that are focused on empowering the underprivileged, include:

1. Making education fully-free and accessible to underprivileged children of our country
2. Creating income-generating opportunities
3. Ensuring food and nutrition security
4. Making healthcare more accessible for the poor

## Active projects

Currently, there are four long-term sustainable projects conducted and executed by OBHIZATRIK Foundation. These projects are:

1. OBHIZATRIK School
2. SHOKKHOM
3. Healthcare and Boat Ambulance
4. Food hangar

These projects focus on facilitating the life and livelihood of the underprivileged of Bangladesh and are in alignment with the SDGs 1, 2, 3 and 4 respectively.

## Food campaigns and emergency relief programs

Beside the long-term projects, OBHIZATRIK Foundation also carries out food campaigns such as:

1. Bina Poysar Bazar
2. Joy of giving
3. Sehri Deen
4. Eid festivals

During national emergencies and natural disasters, the organization provides relief and emergency medicines all over Bangladesh.

# SHOKKHOM

SHOKKHOM is one of the four long-term sustainable projects of OBHIZATRIK Foundation. This project provides fully-developed, free-of-cost business model setups to eradicate poverty. The sustainable livelihood project SHOKKHOM is centered on improving the lives and livelihood of underprivileged. This project enables them to earn their own livelihood instead of having to depend on others.

“ *SHOKKHOM aims to alleviate poverty and eradicate it in the long-run. Through training modules incorporated within the project, SHOKKHOM helps to build financial resiliency among the beneficiaries.* ”

The idea of SHOKKHOM was to utilize the Zakat given by donors to bring about long-term positive change for the underprivileged. Besides our designated SHOKKHOM officers, the department also has a dedicated 'Zakat committee' that regularly advises the team. SHOKKHOM candidates are selected through a 4-step process that involves taking applications, evaluation of potential candidates, candidate selection and training and finally project handover.

**Active areas**

SHOKKHOM is currently active in 8 districts. The project's beneficiaries are found in Dhaka, Rangpur, Kushtia, Patuakhali, Gazipur, Khagrachari, Barisal and Mymensingh.

**Type of projects**

SHOKKHOM offers its candidates fully developed projects under the following categories:

- 1. Agro-based models
- 2. Livestock business models
- 3. Transportation based models
- 4. Small enterprise



# OBHIZATRIK SCHOOL



OBHIZATRIK School was inaugurated in 2013 with a view to making quality education accessible for the underprivileged children of our country. Education is one of many fundamental rights of every human being. But in Bangladesh, many children are deprived of this right due to poverty in family and the expensive education system. Children who are deprived of basic education face many challenges in their adult life.

OBHIZATRIK School aims to uproot this long-running problem prevalent in our country. This school focuses on the less-privileged children. It's fully free and provides its students with all sorts of learning accessories so that no student drops out due to the expense.

### Facilities provided to students:

1. Monthly health check-up
2. Nutritious meals, grocery bags and Eid meals
3. Annual study tours and picnics
4. Yearly sports and cultural festivals
5. Gifts and dresses during Eid
6. Creative skills building and self-defense classes

Besides the above, our students also receive free stationeries, scholarships on the basis of monthly exams, school uniforms and arts and crafts materials regularly.

# FOOD HANGAR

The 'Food hangar' project is a socially inclusive project funded by Daraz Cares and which aims to address the issue of hunger. Suitably named 'Amar Dawat', this project has been designed to provide a light meal of bread, banana and tea to anyone or everyone who asks for it.

The stores where food hangar is active also acts as platforms for bringing together people from different social and economic background. This gives people a chance to leave a donation and contribute to preventing hunger problems in Bangladesh. The food hangar project is currently active in 30 shops across Dhaka with approximately 9000 people benefitting from it every month.

Under the Food and Nutrition program, OBHIZATRIK Foundation also carries out four other food campaigns beside the 'Food hangar' project. The goal of this food campaigns are to ensure food security among the less privileged people. These campaigns are: Joy of Giving, Bina Poysar bazar, Shobar jonno iftar, Seheri Deen. The objective of the Food and Nutrition Program is to mitigate hunger and poverty-related starvation among the less-privileged.

# OTHERS

The boat ambulance 'M.B. Payra' was designed by OBHIZATRIK Foundation team and funded by IDLC Finance Limited. The idea of the boat ambulance occurred when OBHIZATRIK School's Latachar campus construction was underway. The project was finally launched in 2019. 'M.B. Payra' has the capacity to reach patients from Rangabali, Chalitabunia, Char Mantaj, Choto Baishdia and Boro Baishdia under Rangabali upazila. The boat can accommodate 10 people at a time and includes 2 patient beds to transport to the nearest headquarters hospital within 30 minutes. The boat is also engaged in providing emergency medicine and food relief during floods and other natural disasters.

### Boat ambulance features:

1. 26-foot long and 8-foot wide boat having net accommodation capacity of 10 people
2. Two patient beds to transport critical patients
3. Equipped with first-aid medicine boxes and emergency oxygen cylinder.
4. Engine power of boat 110 HP with top speed of 45 knots.
